Old Business: Cemetery Walkthrough April 11, 2021

East Washington Cemetery: In lot 6 for the 1884 section a grave has settled over the winter leaving a full indentation approximately 8 inches deep which needs to be filled in.

We looked at the back wall, beside the 1908 section, that's leaning in and needs to be straightened out. Kevin wants to get Ed Thayer's opinion on how to repair it.

In the Paul section, the Robert & Lyn Peasley monument was not set properly, but just lying on the ground.

We discussed the need for row markers on the far side of the Paul section.

New Center Cemetery:

Davison monument is off of its base.

A dead Ash tree on the other side of the stone wall, beside the Dole mausoleum is dropping branches and needs to be removed before it falls into the cemetery.

The monument of William Davis is set very shallow and needs shoring up.

The Ansel Train monument has fallen.

Old Center Cemetery:

We didn't find anything outstanding here.

We did discuss the need for fill in some of the low spots.

These are issues we were aware of.

New business:

Meeting to place flags for the Veterans on Sunday April 16, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.

Ed Thayer will email over soil testing information to print out for Kevin.

Kitty West handed Cynthia the key to the filing cabinet.
