Old Business

- Corner Marker Sets- we have received them and have not yet seen a bill for repair work. Bill should have been mailed to the town. The company is Peterborough Marble and Granite Works, LLC.
- Update on stone walls- Harris Rockwells- will not be able to schedule anything until the spring. If he has a cancelation he will contact Kevin.
- Custom Exit/ Entrance signs- Kevin- still in process-
- Veteran flag holder/marker- Cynthia contact three companies- cheapest was VFW \$23.95 apiece with shipping

Discussion: should we order US Veterans or specific ones for Vets; WWI, WWII etc. Kevin has asked Cynthia to order once they have made a decision on the type of markers. Kevin would like to see what we have in the center cemetery before ordering. Kevin will take inventory this week. Kevin suggests we place the markers on October 17th. - Veterans to add: Bill Mulcahy genealogical researcher has found three revolutionary veterans whose graves at Old Center Cemetery have not been marked. Trustees will add the names Joshua Haynes, John Healy, and Deacon Ebenezer Jaquith to the books and will mark their graves with Revolutionary War markers.
- Soil testing- waiting for results
- Row marker work - goal for the trustees is to fix issues with row markers. Can be scheduled up to November 1st.
- Resignation of Cynthia Dressel Accepted by Chairman Kevin Lawrence and Dale Havunen. She will be staying on for a 30 day period to train Donna Stone.
- Addition of Donna Stone as a new trustee. Dale Havunen and Cynthia Dressel
