Old Business:

Phil will contact Ed Thayer about some concerns with the cemetery maintenance in the old section of the New Center Cemetery.

New Business:

Bob Cilley attended our meeting to see if a monument could be placed on one of his parents' lots for his brother Carroll, even though Carroll's ashes will not be interred there but scattered on Draper Hill. He gave us permission to remove the overgrown shrubs on his parent's lots.

A Right to Inter was sold for a lot in the Cremains garden this month.

It was discovered that the wrong lot number was recorded on a Right to Inter for a lot in the East Washington Cemetery, last October. Phil will contact the purchaser to return the contract for a new one with the correct lot number.

We had two ash interments in July; one in East Washington and one in the New Center Cemetery.

Phil suspected that Harold Hunt had traded his lots in the Old Section of the New Center Cemetery for lots in the new section. However, the town clerk's records show that he purchased the lots in the new Section.
