3.0 BUILDING PERMITS:

- 3.1 Robin Trudelle, Tm. # 14-350 requesting a revision on the previously approved garage (24 X 28). Re: change from a 24 X 28' garage to a 24 X 30 garage. Tabled
- 3.2 Cecile Bushey, Tm. # 20-81 requesting a building permit to complete the construction of a 24 X 24' Post & Beam cottage, previously approved in 2019 (permit # 19-23) Dube moved to approve the building permit Marshall second all voted in favor. Permit # 22-51.
- 3.3 Pam and James Daragon Tm. # 13-16-01 requesting a building permit to construct and replace roof over door garage 48" X 20'. Dube moved to approve the building permit, Marshall second all voted in favor. Permit # 22-52.
