Limitation of Use: Except as explicitly provided in Section V below, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle weighing more than six (6) tons on any Limited Weight Street Highway from March 1 to May 31 or as deemed necessary.

SECTION V

Exceptions: The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to:

- A. Any motor vehicle operated by the Town.
- B. Any permitted business in the Town of Washington operating a Motor Vehicle empty over six (6) tons from their place of business to and from N.H. Route 31 and N.H. Route 10.
- C. Delivery vehicles making occasional trips to service residences.
