Findings of Fact

Variance Criteria	Satisfied?
Variances must not be contrary to the public interest	Yes ^[1]
The spirit of the Land Use Ordinance will be observed	Yes ^[1]
Substantial justice will be done	Yes ^[1]
The values of surrounding properties will not be diminished	Yes ^[1]
Literal enforcement of the Land Use Ordinance would result in unnecessary hardship	Yes ^[1]

1: Variance from LUO **\$**306 unnecessary

The application suggests that a variance from LUO **\$**306 is required. However, the only relevant provision of **\$**306 simply specifies that the setback requirements of **\$**202 be met.

THEREFORE: The Board finds that a variance from any of the provisions of LUO **\$**306 is unnecessary.
